# Competition Rules & Regulations

The 2025 National Clubs Carnival will be conducted under the **2025 Technical Regulations** and FIG Code of Points 2025 - 2028 for the respective GymSports.

These documents are currently available on the Gymnastics Australia website. Please ensure you read all relevant document before submitting entries.

Information around athlete numbers and team sizes can be found in the Technical Regulations for each GymSport.

## Orientation Meeting

For this years event the orientation meeting will be pre recorded and sent out to all participating clubs.

Once available, the recorded session will be emailed directly so please keep your eye out.

It is a requirement that all clubs watch the orientation meeting in full prior to arriving at the event, as it contains important information to support a smooth and successful competition experience.

# Athlete Withdrawals & Refunds

Should a club need to withdraw an athlete from the event, we ask that you please complete the official Withdrawal Form [HERE](#).

This same form is also where clubs can submit an application for an entry fee refund. Please note the following:

- All refund applications must be submitted no later than Friday, 31 October.
- A valid medical certificate is required in order for a refund to be processed.
- Medical certificates must be uploaded directly through the withdrawal/refund form – certificates sent separately by email will not be accepted.

Clubs are not required to submit the withdrawal and refund applications at the same time. For example, a withdrawal can be lodged promptly, with the refund application submitted later once the required medical certificate has been obtained.

We recommend contacting your club directly for information regarding arrival times for your specific competition session.

## Competition Workplans

Competition workplans are currently being drafted and will be published as soon as they are available.

Once released, all workplans will be emailed directly to clubs and will also be accessible on the event website.

We ask that clubs carefully review the workplans upon publication to ensure all relevant athletes have been correctly captured. Prompt checking will help us finalise the schedule and address any discrepancies early.

# Safer Sport Course Requirements

At this year's event, all coaches and judges will be required to complete the Gymnastics Australia You've Got This course, available through Flex.

Gymnastics Australia requires officials to provide evidence of the following items prior to collecting their accreditation;

- A valid Working With Children Check (or equivalent)
- Photo ID

This year, Gymnastics Australia will verify the relevant education course completion prior to officials' arrival at the event, to ensure a smooth process for all at the accreditation center. Officials need to have their SIA and GA certificates easily accessible if required.



# Medical Coverage

Doctors and Physiotherapists will be onsite for the duration of the competition to assist with any injuries that occur during warm-up or competition.


If an athlete requires support for an existing or ongoing injury, please speak with one of the medical staff, who can connect you with a suitable local provider.

In the event of an injury during competition, athletes should not be moved until assessed by the medical team.

Ice will also be readily available throughout the event, and athletes and coaches are welcome to help themselves as needed

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# FIG Academy Readiness Workshop for Coaches

As part of the upcoming National Clubs Carnival, we're offering two specialised 1.5 hour readiness workshops to support coaches preparing for the FIG Level 1 Academy in January 2026. While particularly valuable for Academy participants, all coaches seeking to refresh or extend their knowledge are welcome.

## Biomechanics Workshop

This session will explore key concepts from the FIG 1 Academy, including principles of stability, forces, inertia, trajectory, rotational mechanics, and swing. Coaches will strengthen their understanding of how these principles underpin skill development and performance.

## Anatomy Workshop

Covering anatomical terminology, axes and planes, bone structures, tendons and ligaments, and joint movement, this workshop also highlights commonly injured joints in gymnastics. Coaches will leave with stronger foundations for applying anatomical knowledge to athlete development and safe coaching practice.

Both workshops cover both topics and provide an opportunity for coaches from intermediate to high-performance levels to build confidence, strengthen technical knowledge, and prepare for the FIG Academy. Attendees will receive 3 updating points.



# Award Ceremonies

All awards will be presented in accordance with the 2025 Technical Regulations for each GymSport, with placings awarded from 1st through to 6th place.

Ties will be recognised and resolved as outlined in the Technical Regulations.

Attendance at the relevant awards ceremony is compulsory for all athletes, and failure to attend will result in the award or placing being reallocated.

Athletes are expected to wear their club attire or uniform during the ceremony, with socks or gym shoes required. Street shoes are not permitted.

To ensure a smooth and timely ceremony, athletes are asked to marshal promptly at the conclusion of their competition session.


